Tasting Notes: Rusty in color, this has a baked fruit aromas suggestive of raisin, cherry and plum. It's thick, but it maintains freshness due to the solid acidity. This feels heavy, with robust flavors of roasted plum and blackberry, but the finish isn't cloying. — M.S. Wine Enthusiast (10/01/2012).

Food Pairing: Sweet desserts.

Serve at: 46-50°F

Vinification: The over-ripened grapes undergo peculiar maceration under cold controlled temperature and are partially fermented in French oak barrels.

Alcohol: 13.5% by Vol.
